
School is open from the 1st June. We have attached a few activities to keep you busy. The packs will be slightly smaller as we will be updating them every week.

Phonics


We will be practising phase 3 phonics

Writing


- Letter formation

- Write a caption for the pictures









• Phoneme frames - write the words to match to the picture

- How many different ways can you make a number? Record or take photos




Body Measure


 Use Lego bricks to measure parts of your body. How long is your foot? Can you make a table to record your findings?
