Lottery News

We are very excited to announce that, following a successful bid to The National Lottery Comminuty Fund, we have been awarded £10,000. The fund distributes money raised by National Lottery



players for good causes and is the largest funder of community activity in the UK. We will use the money to redevelop our outdoor early years play area which will include artificial grass surfacing, water table, water wall, water channels, mud kitchen and play tables. The aim is that this area will also become a recreation space that can benefit the wider community with local groups having access to the facilities outside school hours. This community project will get children active and also encourage people from our community to mix together once we have come through the COVID pandemic. Work starts on the 24th May and should be complete by half term so watch this space!
