#### **Eat Them to Defeat Them**



This year we are taking part in the Eat Them to Defeat Them campaign. Through a unique partnership between Veg Power, ITV, Channel 4 and Sky, plus the support of supermarkets, growers, devolved and local government, the Eat Them to Defeat Them campaign is bringing about real changes in children's attitudes towards vegetables. Research shows that 80% of our children are not eating enough vegetables with a

third eating less than one portion a day. As a school we would like to play our part in changing these statistics. If children get to enjoy veg now, they will like it all their lives and will accept and enjoy a healthier diet. Eat Them to Defeat Them packs will be sent some with the children this week and our lunchtime staff will be giving out stickers to encourage the children to eat their vegetables each day.
