Stubbington Study Centre

Stubbington Study Centre's open day takes place tomorrow, Saturday 11th March, from 10am to 4pm. The open day is an ideal opportunity for parents and carers of children in Years 3 and 4 to view the centre together with their child prior to their visit (Year 4 in 2023 and Year 3 in 2024). Parking is very limited so the advice is to park in Monks Hill car park or on Lee on Solent seafront.



Key Reminders

- Please note that the school car park is not to be used by parents and carers at any time unless you have a blue badge (on display in the car) or have been given prior permission by the school. As you are aware, it is a small car park and is not even sufficient for the number of staff onsite. It is also essential that we keep the car park free of moving cars for the safety of our children, parents and visitors.
- We ask that parents and carers are also considerate of our neighbours when parking to collect or drop off children to school. There is free parking available at the community centre and in the Station Road car park and 30 minutes free parking in Wickham Square. These areas should be used for parking in the first instance. Please do not cause obstruction or endanger the safety of others by parking inconsiderately in residential areas. Where local residents have raised concerns with the school, we have asked that they report these to the Police.
- We have recently had some cases of sickness in school and we would like to remind you that your child cannot return to school until **48 hours** after their last episode of sickness or diarrhoea. This is the period that is stipulated by the NHS and the UK Health Security Agency (HSA) in order to avoid any spread of sickness across the school. Your child will be sent home if they return within this 48-hour period.
