We were please to return to school to find that the scaffolding has now been removed in the hall. Our new windows look fantastic and have made a real difference to the brightness in the hall. The roofing work has also now been completed and the scaffolding on the outside of the building will be coming down over the next couple of weeks. The grass at the front of the school will be reseeded in the spring. We would like to thank you for your patience whilst this work has been carried out. ## **Wrap Around Care**

Further to the sudden closure of Treetops before and after school club we are delighted to be able to continue to offer wrap around care for our children. We have successfully run before and after school sessions since mid-December with the same staff team, Miss Jade, Miss Lorraine and Miss Tara. This term we introduced a convenient online booking system using scopay which enables you to book sessions up to one month in advance. We have also made arrangements for parents to pay using the tax free childcare scheme or using childcare vouchers from various companies.

#### **Support for Service Families**

We are also pleased to be able to support he government's new initiate for service families. From Autumn 2022, eligible Service personnel (Tri-Service) can apply for up to 20 hours per week, term time only (39 weeks per year) of wraparound childcare funding for 4- to 11-year-old children attending before and after school clubs in the UK. This is facilitated through the tax free childcare system and therefore you will need an account for this in order to participate. ## **Wickham Pre School**

Do you have a child ready to start pre-school this September? We currently have some spaces at our pre-school but these are filling up fast. We take children from two years old and from September we will be open from 8am to 5pm, Monday to Friday. We accept children with the 15 and 30 hour funding and additional sessions or those without funding are able to attend at the rates in the table below.
